
Comparison of 2019/20 and 2020/21 Data in Post-M.D. Training

The COVID-19 pandemic has changed almost every aspect of our daily lives. That is particularly the case for those who work in healthcare given the direct impact of the pandemic on their work. The question remains as to whether the pandemic has had an impact on the type and volume of post-M.D. trainees entering training in Canada.



The total number of residents increased slightly between 2019/20 and 2020/21. This trend held for both Canadian Citizens / Permanent Residents (CC/PR) and Visa trainees.

2019/20 2020/21

Year-over-year there was a marked drop in the number of fellows training in Canada. There were 50 fewer CC/PR fellows and 108 fewer Visa fellows. This represented a total drop of 158 fellows from 2019/20 to 2020/21.
