


### **AFMCs Data Roots**

During the postwar years, the schools devoted much time and energy to integrating returning medical officers into civilian medical practice and coping with the influx of veterans, who comprised up to 25 per cent of entering classes. Postwar demands on the schools also focused attention on the need for nationwide planning and action, and the association became the repository for data on student applications and admissions.

### **AFMCs Data Roots - ORIS**

- Work carried out by the Office of Research and Information Services (ORIS) dates back to the post-WWII period
- Main data areas covered by ORIS include:
  - MD program application, enrolment, graduation
  - Tuition fees
  - Faculty and graduate student counts
  - Research funding



### **AFMCs Data Roots - CAPER**

- Founded in 1986, the Canadian Post-MD Education Registry (CAPER) is a partnership of professional medical organizations and F/P/T governments.
- Main data areas covered by CAPER include:
  - Post-MD enrolment & exits
  - Ongoing practice location




Total Number of Applicants and Applications to MD Programs, Canada, 1980/81 - 2006/07


MD Program Applications/Applicants and First Year Enrolment/Applicants, Canada, 1980/81 - 2006/07

MD Program Applicants Per 100,000 Population Aged 20-24 Years, by Sex, Canada, 1980/81-2006/07



Percent Of MD Program Applicants That Are <23 Years of Age, Canada, 1986/87-2006/07



# Canadian Citizen/Permanent Resident MD Program Tuition Fees by Faculty of Medicine, Fall 2007





### **Medical Students' Estimated Debt**


Medical Students' Self-Reported Debt, Québec Students Vs. Students Outside Québec, 2007/08


First Year MD Program Enrolment, Canada, 1980/81 - 2007/08



# First Year MD Program Enrolment, by Faculty of Medicine Canada, 2002/03 and 2007/08






MD Program Enrolment, Canada, 1980/81 - 2007/08

First Year MD Program Students by Sex, Canada, 1980/81 - 2007/08





#### Faculty of Medicine Full-Time Faculty and MD Students, Canada, 1997/98-2005/06





# Physician Average Weekly Work Hours (excluding on-call), by Type of Activity, 2004 and 2007







### First Year Post-MD Residency Enrolment, by Faculty of Medicine Canada, 2002/03 and 2007/08






Total Post-MD Enrolment by Sex, Canada, 1990/91 - 2007/08


Change in First Year Post-MD Enrolment by Broad Specialty, Canada, 1998/99 - 2007/08


Indexed Change in First Year Post-MD Enrolment by Broad Specialty,


Change in First Year Post-MD Enrolment for High Growth Programs, Canada, 1998/99 - 2007/08


Change in First Year Post-MD Enrolment for High Growth Programs, Canada, 1998/99 - 2007/08

**Distribution of First Year Post-MD Trainees Across Broad Specialties** 





Distribution of First Year Post-MD Trainees Across Broad Specialties by Faculty of Medicine Providing Post-MD Training, Canada, 2006/07








Legal Status of Post-MD IMG Trainees, Canada, 2005/06-2007/08


Percent of Post-MD Trainees Who Are IMGs, by Faculty of Medicine, Canada, 2007/08

MD Country Top 10 for IMG Post-M.D. Trainees, Canada. 2005/06 - 2007/08



IMG Training Rank Distribution - Visa Trainees Included, Canada, 2005/06 - 2007/08









Number of IMGs in Canada Two Years After Completion of Post-MD Training in Canada, 1996/97 - 2005/06 Practice Entry Cohorts




# Family Medicine IMGs in Canada 2 Years After Post-MD Training

Percent of IMGs in Canada Two Years After Completion of Post-MD Training in Canada, 1996-2005 Practice Entry Cohorts
















### First Year Enrolment in Medical Schools (including 40-50 Visa students)


# Practice Entry Cohorts 1997 to 2007 (excludes visa trainees)



# Physician Resource Evaluation Template (PRET)

- Practice entry cohort from CAPER largest gain variable in model.
- Undergraduate enrolment from ORIS used to estimate future practice entry cohorts
- Data supplied by age, sex and specialty.
- Location of new physicians crucial for retention calculations for provincial

projections.
