

Individual Field of Training Tables

A set of tables have been prepared showing the faculty of medicine providing training for each specialty and subspecialty field in Canada. The rank level of residents enrolled in each program at each faculty on Nov 1, 2012 is given.

Two tables are given for each training field.

- 1: Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents vs. Visa Trainees – The group of Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents is our best estimate of the physicians who will become new family physicians and specialists for Canada. Visa Trainees although undertaking post-M.D. training in Canada, do not have the legal status required to stay and practice medicine in Canada.
- 2: Regular Ministry Funded vs. All Other Sources of Funding – Regular Ministry Funded trainees have funding provided by the appropriate provincial government ministry responsible for the training of residents within each province. For those that are not Regular Ministry Funded, the main source of funds comes from contracts between the faculty of medicine and foreign governments.
